# IV. Downtown West Development Agreement

City staff will provide an overview of the staff-recommended Draft Development Agreement for Google's proposed project (Downtown West Mixed-use Plan). This includes the following information:

- Background context on the project, engagement process, the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City and Google, and City Council direction.
- Summaries of what the Development Agreement says about: affordable housing; economic opportunity; parks and open space; transportation; environmental sustainability; and key business terms
- Overview of the Community Benefits Plan, including the overall value, timing, and relationship to other project benefits.
- Details on the Community Stabilization and Opportunity Pathways Fund, including its intended uses and the structure for its administration.

Following the presentation, each SAAG member will be given an opportunity to provide comments and questions in a round robin. We will request for SAAG members to limit these initial remarks to approximately two minutes. Additional discussion may follow once all members have had an opportunity to speak.

Staff will compile the feedback and share it with the Planning Commission and City Council for their consideration.
