## Background

#### 2014 DSAP

- Diversity of community services and facilities
- Open Spaces Concept: Distributed spaces interconnected with walkways and paseos.

### Environment has changed

- Large multi-acre "suburban parks" not envisioned; focus shifted to urban park concepts
- "Daylighting" Los Gatos Creek not feasible at this time
- DSAP Amendments projected parkland goal of
  62 acres or equivalent recreation amenities
  (3 acres per 1k new residents)
  - Meeting the goal through Land Dedication, In-Lieu Fee, or Recreation Improvements





## **Key Priorities**

- Identifying preferred trail alignment and open space areas
- Complete Los Gatos Creek Trail as Paved Off– Road Corridor
- Creating small interconnected parks and open spaces
- Centralized community center with multiple services and types of spaces
- Providing programs and services that emphasize job training, continuing education and access to opportunity
